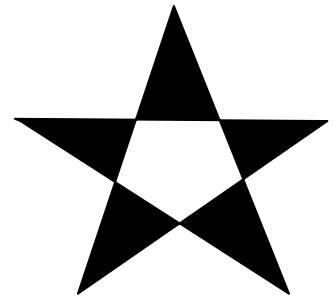


BE A STAR!!

Compete in the Business Bowl!



NOTE: At YBA you will be put into a group of students called a “company”. Three students from each company will be chosen by the members of the company to be the Business Bowl contestants. Those chosen are usually the most skilled in knowing the business terms.

IMPORTANT: In the Business Bowl Game you do not have to give the definition. When the moderator reads the definition, you must be able to say the term which is only 1 to 3 words.

YOUTH BUSINESS ADVENTURE (YBA) BUSINESS BOWL RULES

1. Each company will be represented by 3 players chosen by their group.
2. Companies will be drawn at random for the first round of competition.
3. Business Bowl is a single elimination tournament.
4. **Preliminary rounds** will consist of 10 toss-up questions each with a possible 10 bonus questions. If a team is in the process of answering when the buzzer rings, that team will be allowed to continue the answer (including the bonus question). The team with the higher score at the round’s end will advance.
5. Individuals answer the toss-up questions; the team may confer on the bonus questions.
6. The team that answers the toss-up question first gets to answer the bonus question.
7. Miss the toss-up question and your opponent gets a chance to answer.
8. If a question goes to the opposition team, that team must ring their buzzer before being allowed to answer.
9. If a contestant rings the buzzer before the moderator has completed reading the question, the moderator will stop reading the question, and the contestant will have to answer the question with only the information given at the time the buzzer sounded.
10. Toss-up questions will only be repeated when answered incorrectly.
11. Contestants have 10 seconds to answer each question.
12. Toss-up questions are worth 2 points. Bonus questions are worth 1 point.
13. The moderator will be the judge of all answers.
14. Questions will cover the attached business and economic terms.
15. In the case of a tie at the end of a game, there will be a “sudden death” play-off.
16. The buzzer system will be used to determine who will answer the toss-up question first.
17. In the finals, 2 teams will be left to compete to win 1st and 2nd places. The next 2 finalists will face each other for 3rd and 4th places. The **final round** will consist of 15 toss-up questions with a possible 15 bonus questions.
18. All companies in the winning bracket will receive 5 bonus points.
